

Dear Parents and Guardians:

We were notified today that a person has tested positive for coronavirus (COVID-19). Contact tracing has been conducted and staff and students that are considered close contacts have been contacted. As a result of this information, we will move to <u>virtual instruction</u> with our Junior class from Thursday, March 4 through Tuesday, March 16. We will continue with in-person instruction with all other grade levels at this time. If there is a need to change to virtual instruction with additional students, we will send communication as soon as this is determined. In-person instruction with our Junior class will resume on Wednesday, March 17.

Siblings and family members of a possible exposure are not required to quarantine unless they come into contact with a person who tests positive.

ACT testing scheduled for March 9 has been postponed and will take place at a later date. The date will be communicated to you as soon as we have confirmation. Other school events are being reviewed and if there are changes to current plans these will be communicated via School Messenger.

Any students or staff members experiencing illnesses with symptoms resembling those of coronavirus should contact their healthcare provider. The symptoms of coronavirus are similar to the regular seasonal influenza and include fever, lethargy, lack of appetite, and coughing. Some people with coronavirus have reported additional symptoms, such as loss of taste and smell, a runny nose, sore throat, nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea.
